What is Animals & Ales?

It's more than just a pet photo contest — it's a fundraiser for Veterinarians Without Borders (VWB)! Your pet becomes a furry fundraiser, helping raise money to support animal health, emergency veterinary response, and One Health programs in Ukraine, Alaska, and around the world.

Contest Dates: August 11-25, 2025

Whether your pet is a couch potato, a toy-chasing maniac or a goofball, they can be a hero by helping raise funds to support animals, people, and the environment.

Your Mission (If You Choose to Accept It)

Raise as much as you can to support animals in need by sharing your pet's page with friends, family, coworkers, and fellow pet lovers. Every dollar raised = 1 vote in the contest!

Top 1st, 2nd & 3rd fundraisers win amazing prizes and bragging rights — plus the opportunity to be featured on one of three beer labels!

How to Get Started

- **1. Register Your Pet:** Go to wwb.org/animals-and-ales-us-2025, upload a photo, and set a fundraising goal.
- **2. Customize Your Pet's Photo Page:** Write a few sentences about your pet and why you're raising money for VWB. Be heartfelt or funny whatever feels natural.
- **3. Share & Ask:** Use email, social media, and in-person convos to tell people why this matters to you. Tip: start with close friends they're most likely to donate! To help with asking, use the sample copy provided on page 3 and/or the "Sponsor My Pet" card on page 4.













Tips & Tricks To Help You Raise Funds

Start With Your Inner Circle

Family, friends, coworkers, your vet, groomer, dog walker, park friends — anyone who knows and loves your pet.

Make It Personal

Tell people why you care about helping animals, especially in underserved and remote communities that lack access to veterinary care. Go even further by making a \$25 self-donation to inspire others!

Use Photos & Videos

Nothing says "donate now" like a wagging tail or curious kitten. We know you have cute content!

Thank Donors Promptly

A quick text, DM, or shout-out to say "thanks for donating" goes a long way.

Remind Without Being Pushy

Most people need to see something 2–3 times before they take action. It's okay to follow up and remind them to donate/vote for your pet. A little nudge never hurts!

Set Milestones

Keep momentum going by sharing your milestones. For example, "We just hit \$100 — help us reach \$200 by Friday!"

You've Got This!

Did you know there are regions in the U.S. where access to veterinary care is extremely limited? Your pet's fundraiser helps provide real care in real communities, right here at home and around the globe.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is this just a pet photo contest?

No — it's a fundraiser first. Funds raised go directly to Veterinarians Without Borders USA to support their animal health programs in underserved communities across the U.S., including Alaska, as well as around the world.

Where does the money go?

Funds support VWB's work, including:

- Emergency veterinary response
- Animal welfare in remote communities
- Global One Health initiatives that protect people, animals, and ecosystems

Is there a minimum I need to raise?

There's no minimum, but the more you raise, the better your pet's chances of winning — and the more impact you'll have! Check the leaderboard to see where you rank and keep aiming high.

Do donors get tax receipts?

Yes! All donations of \$5 USD or more are eligible for a U.S. charitable tax receipt. They're sent automatically by email.

I don't like asking for money. How do I make this feel more comfortable?

You're not asking for money for you (or your pet)
— you're inviting people to support an important
cause through your adorable pet. Keep it light and
joyful. Most people want to help animals!

We know asking for support can feel a little awkward, but it doesn't have to be! That's why we've created ready-to-use sample messages for social media and email to make it easy. You'll also find a printable "Sponsor My Pet" card on the next page, perfect for sharing with friends, coworkers, or family to rally votes for your special pet.

1. Sample Social Post #1:

Meet Luna the Wonder Dog She's entered in the Animals & Ales pet photo fundraiser to help animals and communities in need across the U.S. and beyond. Every dollar = one vote. Every vote = support for Veterinarians Without Borders' lifesaving work. Can you help Luna raise \$100 for animal health? [Insert your fundraising page link]


