### Animals & Ales 2026

#### Campaign Overview

**Animals & Ales** is a cross-border pet photo fundraiser that unites local breweries, animal lovers, and communities to raise funds for veterinary care in underserved and crisis-affected settings.

From **February 23 to March 16, 2026**, pet guardians are invited to submit photos of their animals, gather votes, and help support animal health programs through a fun, community-led campaign hosted by participating craft breweries.

The campaign is led by **Veterinarians Without Borders North America (VWB)** in partnership with breweries across the U.S. and Canada.

#### What Makes This Newsworthy

- **Local stories within a larger effort:** Each brewery activates its own community while contributing to a shared cause.
- **Highly visual:** Pet photography and custom beer labels offer strong imagery for digital and print coverage.
- **Community impact:** Funds raised support emergency veterinary care, preventive services, and long-term animal health programs.
- **Multi-state participation:** Breweries across diverse U.S. regions are involved.

#### How the Campaign Works

1. Pet owners submit a photo through a participating brewery's contest page.
2. Community members vote to support their favourite pets.
3. Winning pets appear on limited-edition beer labels.
4. Funds raised support animal health and emergency response efforts.
